KELLY VAN ENGELENHOVEN: For those of you who currently send cards and notes of encouragement to Kelly using the United States Postal Services, we want to make you aware of some recent changes that the Department of Corrections has implemented. All mail must adhere to the following guidelines: It must be sent in a standard white envelope, mailing and return addresses must be filled out in writing as the only stick-on item permitted is the stamp. Postcards, commercial cards and handmade cards are Not Permitted. Correspondence must be on a piece of white copy or commercial paper. As previously communicated, a new messaging system has been developed to make the sending and receipt of messages between inmates and family/friends a more automated system.
