January 19: Colossians 1:24-2:5 - Christ, the Power in all Our Sufferings

Struggle in our lives can sometimes bring out our best, and yet, sadly, sometimes our worst. When we struggle – sometimes with our faith, our in life's circumstances, or even in matters of spiritual warfare – there is a testing that taps deep inside us. The question is: what's inside us? Paul tells us clearly that in the midst of his struggles (and the same can be said of us), he struggles "with all His (that is, Christ's) energy that He powerfully works within me." (1:29). The good news is that despite our weakest moments, Christ's power works in the midst of our struggle... we can count on Him!
