Make sure if you receive emails from staff members that the email address ends in @firstchristianreformed.org. If you ever are concerned if something is a scam, please contact church. Usually scam emails sound very urgent, and ask you to reply with personal information. They often have spelling errors, just don't sound like the person, are too formal, or have odd greetings or closings.
