Union Gospel Mission provides nutritious meals, safe shelter from the elements, and other services for the hungry and homeless in Sioux Falls. Their purpose is to "proclaim the gospel of salvation by grace in Christ and Him crucified, for the salvation of souls and the establishing of believers." The organization was founded by Thomas F. Morse, who was convicted of a shooting death in 1893. He gave his heart and life to Jesus Christ while in prison and opened the Sioux Falls City Rescue Mission in 1900.
