#### Lent 2024: Give Up in Order to Give-Starting Feb 18

First CRC is once again partnering with SIMDEL Children's Education Ministry for this year's "Give Up In Order To Give" Lent campaign. The funds from this year's campaign will be used to meet a variety of needs of the children and families in the village of Dzogblakope in Togo, West Africa.

The offerings will be used to provide basic educational services such as uniforms, backpacks, and school supplies, offer optional tutoring services to the approximately 600 children at the school, continue the distribution of solar powered Torch Audio Bibles, maintain a weekly Bible study through a local church in the village for those desiring to learn more about God's Word and His love through His Son, Jesus Christ, and finally, working with some of the local families to create and develop sustainable incomes to meet their most basic physical needs.

In addition to the needed financial support SIMDEL earnestly seeks your prayer support for the leadership team in Togo, as well as the children, families and the church in Togo. An article will be available in the church's weekly newsletter highlighting specific areas of ministry throughout the weeks of Lent. Thank you for your support.
