#### "The Cross of Christ" – Lenten Series for 2025 March 16 – "The Cross of Christ: Judgement and Justice" – Romans 3:9-26

God made very clear from the beginning: sin is disobedience against the living God and the punishment is death. And while God made provision through the sacrificial system to live in covenantal relationship with man, at some point all-encompassing judgement needed to be executed. Yet no man could withstand such all-encompassing wrath... except the God-man, Jesus Christ. This message will explore the nature of God's judgment on sin and the sufficiency of Christ's death on the cross to provide the justice demanded in light of our sin.

#### Lent Campaign 2025- Growing Beyond The Gifts

Our focus this year of our 2025 Lent Campaign will be for the Heytsi family in Tyachiv, Ukraine. Your support this year will help them upgrade their church farm. We hope to help them with the funds to purchase 2 solar panels (\$18,000), construct a root cellar (\$5,000), prep and plant 2 fields (\$900), purchase seeds and plants, and buy 6 piglets (\$300).

A special giving envelope has been placed in your mailbox. Please use this as a reminder throughout the Lent season, as well as to submit your gifts. Place anytime during the Lent season in the offering bag, or in the marked box in the back of the Fellowship Hall. Be listening for more information about this the Heytsi Family and their church farm during the Lent season!

#### From The Heytsi's

First CRC, we are so grateful and thank God for all your support throughout the years. We praise God that you are Giving up to Grow with us this Lent season. With your continued prayers and support, New Life Church bought this small plot of land 2 years ago. Our prayers are that through this farm, we can help with food stability and shortages. In addition to helping provide food, we sell the crops in the market as a small source of income for our church. In the past 2 years, since purchasing the land, we have worked to:

- Clear the land of trees and debris
- build a fence around the land
- build 2 greenhouses
- build a pig barn
- begin to raise 5 goats for milk and meat
- raise chickens for meat and eggs
- are growing small crops of peppers, cucumbers and tomatoes in the greenhouses
- growing corn and beets for the animals food
- growing potatoes, zucchini and raspberries

We praise God for you and your continued support!!"

#### **Electricity in the Ukraine**

"Electricity has never been very reliable in Ukraine, but since the war began, it has gotten much worse. They also have planned times when they shut electricity off for specific hours. We use heaters to keep our greenhouses warm during our cold spring days and nights and so having reliable energy is very important, so that we don't lose our vegetable crop and can continue to grow vegetables in the greenhouses. We plan to purchase solar panels and put them on the roof of our shed, so that we have a more reliable energy supply. Thank you for considering helping in our need to get reliable electricity."
