## "The Cross of Christ" - Lenten Series for 2025

The cross – the emblem of suffering and shame – served as the instrument God ordained for His Son to die on for the sins of mankind. This torture tool – perfected by the Romans – was purposed to produce excruciating pain and a slow, suffocating death. And it was public. Rome used it to deter rebellion against the government, displaying the high price for breaking the law.

But why would God choose such an awful instrument to display His greatest love? The crushing paradox of curse and salvation, judgment and redemption, hate for sin and love for the sinner seemed extreme... yet... fitting. This Lenten Series will explore the ministry and message of Jesus as He encountered the cross. We will focus on the cross through the lens of Jesus, the suffering servant, and through the lens of the Father, the compassionate judge. We will wrestle with the tension of the imagery of the cross to discover our sin that nailed Jesus to the cross and the love of the Father for us through the cross.

Let us humble ourselves before God in this journey. May our hearts own the sin and rebellion in our lives that nailed Jesus to the cross. And may the Spirit of God reveal that through the cross we are loved.

## March 9 – "The Cross of Christ: The Shame and The Servant"

### Scripture: Philippians 2:1-11

The journey to the Cross of Christ is filled with the dynamic tension of all that was wrong in the world colliding with all that is right in the heart of God. The God/man Jesus Christ took this tension on in His incarnation. But how did He do that: with the tremendous burden of man's sin and the just-filled gracious heart of God leading Him to the cross? Simple. He became a servant. His servant's posture throughout the whole ordeal spoke volumes of His heart to complete the just verdict of God and displaying the great love of that same God ... at the same time. We will explore how Christ's servant heart went "toe-to-toe" with the evil of this world to reveal the power and purpose of servanthood at the heart of gospel message.
