
MISSIONS SPOTLIGHT

In case you missed it last week... Streaming - The Ins & Outs

We have four different ways to stream our Sunday services and special events: Vimeo, Website, FaceBook, and YouTube. If you want the most reliable, it is always best to watch on our website, as it will always show the current available livestream, even on days where a glitch or problem may occurs. FaceBook and YouTube are convenient, but less reliable, methods to watch for most all the time, but if a glitch occurs, they will not necessarily 'pickup where we left off' when the stream begins again.

On occasion, something may happen with a streaming computer, encoder, interface, software, or Internet service that we may be able to fix by quickly disconnecting and restarting the stream. If we believe it may be something not quickly fixed, we will continue the stream with the audio or video glitch rather than to not air the livestream at all, then fix it between services if we can. The idea is that we always want to bring you the best quality stream available under the conditions given. If watching on our website, you'll also be able to see any livestream message any time there is a glitch that is being addressed.

Bottom line - tune in on the website for the most reliable livestream and information about the stream, or as a backup if you have any problems with FaceBook or YouTube. If you prefer the convenience of jumping on FaceBook or YouTube, that's why we copy our stream there! Keep on using these tools, but if you run into a problem, head over to the website, we'll be there too!
